CHURCH OF THE HOLY TRINITY

THESE BUILDINGS, THE GIFT OF SERENA RHINELANDER, WERE DESIGNED IN FRENCH GOTHIC STYLE BY J. STEWART BARNEY AND CONSECRATED IN 1899 AS THE CHURCH OF THE HOLY TRINITY IN THE PARISH OF ST. JAMES. THE ORIGINAL HOLY TRINITY CHURCH, ORGANIZED IN 1864, WAS LOCATED AT MADISON AVENUE AND FORTY-SECOND STREET UNTIL ITS CONSOLIDATION IN 1895 WITH ST. JAMES' CHURCH. IN 1951 HOLY TRINITY AGAIN BECAME AN INDEPENDENT PARISH.
